How to use

- Before use, carefully read the directions on the packaging and act accordingly.
- The surface should be clean, dry and free of grease. Remove loose old lacquer and rust and sand the surface.
- The surface should be clean, dry and free of grease. The aerosol should have room temperature. Best processing temperature 10 to 25°C. Before use, shake the aerosol for 2 minutes and spray a sample. Distance to the surface to be treated approximately 25 to 30 centimeter.
- Apply the spray paint in several thin layers. Before applying the next layer, again shake the aerosol. When desired, after drying a primer and a lacquer can be applied.
- After use, clean the valve (turn aerosol upside down and press the nozzle for approximately 5 seconds).
